**I hope this article inspires you to travel with your kids. It's an amazing experience that will create memories that will last a lifetime.**

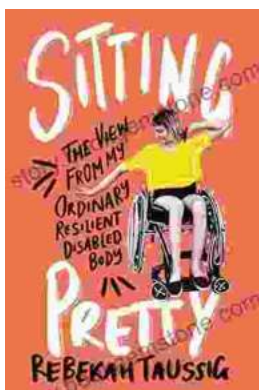
