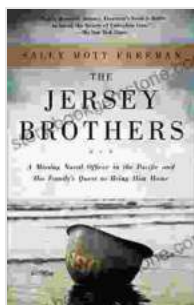


The Vanished Officer: A Family's Unwavering Quest to Bring Home Their Lost Son from the Pacific

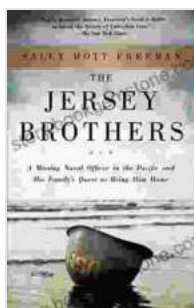

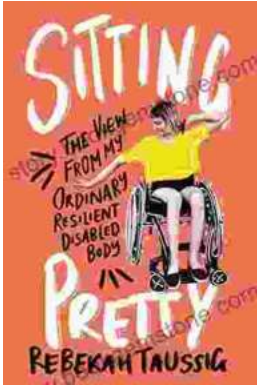
